



How to make Corn Letters

Fast growing fun in making corn letters or patterns

What you need:

Someone to help



Space in the garden



Spade and rake



Twig



Mixed corn and water



What you do:

- Get permission from an adult to create your corn letters and patterns
- Dig a patch in the garden to break up the soil (it needs to be at least 70 cm in height)
- Rake it
- Draw your name/pattern in the soil with a twig
- Go over this and make a shallow channel (known as a drill)
- Sprinkle the mixed corn seed in the channel (they can be planted quite close together)
- Cover seeds with the soil, pat them down gently and then water the letters/pattern
- The corn should spout in about 2 days
- Take a photo every day to see how quick it grows.
- After a small amount of time you will be able to eat your corn if you continue to water this.
